1:10 PM Acres of "Black Liquid" Diamonds: The Naked Truth About Stripper Wells Warren Martin

In this presentation, we will start with a story told by Russell H. Conwell entitled, "Acres of Diamonds". We will explore how this story mimics the mistake in many industries to overlook aspects of their business that might seem less important, but really are essential to the industry. We will explore the history of the Strategic Petroleum Reserve (SPR); contents, purpose, usage and importance. We will delineate the difference between stripper wells and marginal wells. We will explore how stripper wells impact jobs and revenue in predominantly rural counties. We will then compare the SPR to stripper well production (similarities and differences). Then, in the presentation, we will explore a hypothetical scenario where stripper wells are forced to shut down and explore the ramifications of the loss of production from those wells. We will explore how this would impact local economies, and national leverage in energy markets. The purpose of the hypothetical is to identify the crucial role stripper wells play in the oil and natural gas industry. Participants will discover, no matter what level of production their company is involved in, they should have a understanding and appreciate for the impact stripper wells have on the entire industry and U.S. influence in the world energy market.
